

FROM THE DESK OF DEACON DON

This weekend we celebrate the solemnity of the most Holy Trinity and it is most fitting to reflect on how God revealed himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We confess the mystery in the Nicene Creed each Sunday, but how did we learn from it? Not by gazing at his creation. None knew God had a Son, though God gave a hint of it in the creation account. He said, "Let us make man in our image and

likeness." And in the first reading today we had the account of God's Wisdom, whom today we call the Word of God. But who suspected before Christ came that Wisdom was a second Person in God? Who suspected God had a Son, the "first-born of his ways"? The Son of God became known to us only when God gave us his Son to be our Son. We learned of Him only when the Father sent an angel to say to Our Lady, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you. Therefore, the child to be born will be called Holy, the Son of God. St. Pope John Paul 2 said, "Mary of Nazareth is the first believer of the New Covenant to experience the one God in three Persons, the source of all life, all Light, all Love. And how did we learn of the Holy Spirit, the 3rd person of the Blessed Trinity? We learned when he descended on Jesus at His baptism. Even these events did not make it very clear that the Holy Spirit is the 3rd person of the Trinity. Jesus made it clear at the Last Supper, from which today's Gospel reading comes. And as we grow and learn in our family life, we too learn something of the mystery of the Trinity. This weekend we celebrate Father's Day and

God has called all fathers to be the spiritual leader of the family. God has called all Fathers to exemplify that first person of the Trinity; to be Godly in all we do; to be Godly examples to our wives and children. I pray that all Fathers, Grandfathers,



stepfathers, and Godfathers have the Son Jesus Christ in their hearts. I pray that all Fathers be led by the Holy Spirit in everything they do. Happy Father's Day. God bless all.

While others can be involved beneficially in helping to educate children in faith, the Catechism goes on to say (#2226) "Family catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray, and to discover their vocation as children of God." The National Directory for Catechesis acknowledges that parents are the first educators and have a unique responsibility for the education of their children. This is a great honor as "parents are the most influential agents of catechesis for their children." With children being home from school, summer provides more time together as a family and more opportunities to share lived experiences of the faith! There is an abundant wealth of ideas on the internet! Here is a resource of ideas to try to help keep the flame of Christ burning and growing stronger through the summer. 



Today we celebrate the feast day of the Blessed Trinity. The word Trinity is a title for God that tells us that He is three Persons in one God.

Before Jesus came, the people didn't know that God was a Trinity. The Israelites knew that there was only one God, but they didn't know very much about Him. Jesus showed the people that there were three Persons in God when He taught them about Himself and the Father and the Holy Spirit.

The three Persons in the Blessed Trinity are all equal but different. We cannot understand this, but we believe it because Jesus taught it. It is one of the Mysteries of our Faith.

What does the Holy Trinity do for us? We know that God the Father made everything and we are intended to go back to Him. The Holy Spirit guides us towards Him, and Jesus is the way.

Every time you make the Sign of the Cross or say the "Glory Be" you are praying to the Blessed Trinity.
