# 2 FROM THE DESK OF FATHER MATT

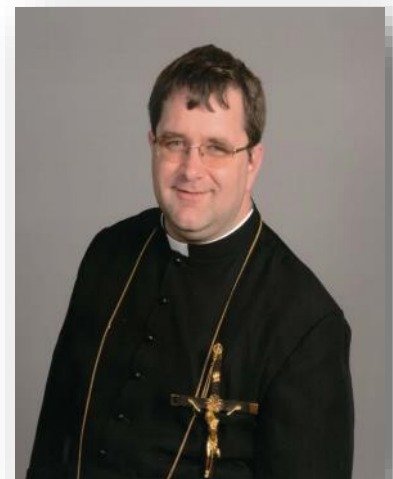

We are living in a world right now that seems to have morals and values that are all mixed up, from the message of the gospel. And when we try to speak up to correct or to say that this is not right. Our God says that this is not right, this how we are called the live the message of the gospel. The world seems to not be too receptive to what we have to say. As a matter of fact, the world rather than accepting our message, the world paints the picture that we are the ones in the wrong. That we are the ones that need to change. With the condition that our world is in right now it would seem as though darkness is winning but rest assured the Light of Christ dispels all darkness the light of Christ triumphs over darkness.

It seems for the first time that we live in world that seem to reject the message of the gospel, the message of our God. But this is not the first time and I do not think it will be the last time. Jesus in the scriptures tells "If the world hates you, realize that it hated me first." (John 15:18). Even before Jesus there was people that rejected the message of God. In our scriptures today we encounter Jeremiah who was a prophet. He was a prophet that had a message that was not very popular. Jeremiah says that he has been duped, tricked, mocked for preaching the message of God. In our scriptures today we hear him say "Yes, I hear the whisperings of many: 'Terror on every side! Denounce! Let us denounce him!'" (Jeremiah 20:10). Yet it is amid trail and persecution Jeremiah does not back down from sharing God's message. He trusts that the LORD is with him, "like a mighty champion my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph" (Jeremiah 20:11). Do we have the faith and the courage of Jeremiah to share God's message, a message that may seem to be an unpopular message trusting that no harm will come to us, trusting that the Lord is there to protect us? Trusting that those persecuting us will be defeated.

It is so easy when we share an 'unpopular' message with the world, when we are being mocked for our message or being threatened to back down out of fear or not say anythin. Jesus tells us to fear no one. Jesus goes on to point out that sparrows are sold and fall out of sky without going unnoticed by his Father. I grew up being taught that sparrows are nuisance birds. If something that seems to have little value is important to our God, then we who are of great value to our God is even more important to our God will not go unnoticed. Sparrows go about doing their business with trust and faith that no harm will come to them. May we have that same trust and faith of sparrows to be about doing our work sharing the message of God with the world, with trust that no harm can come to us.

Yes, sometimes a bird falls out of the sky and sometimes we might get in trouble for preaching the message of Christ and might need to face the consequences. Our church is filled with a history of examples men and women that have done this, we called them martyrs, they are heroes of our faith. May we have the faith preach the message of Christ with trust no harm can come to us. Not being afraid to give witness, willing to give our live for Christ. For we know the light of Christ triumphs over all darkness.



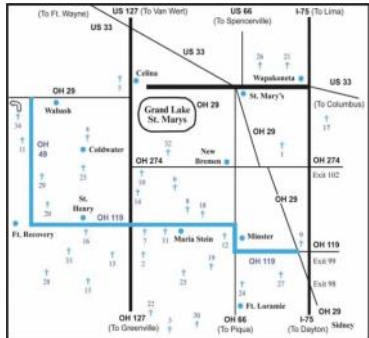
