Jesus is risen!!! Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!! The king of kings is out of the tomb. New life, new beginnings, new creation, resurrection!! God wants us to experience his love, mercy, and peace right now. He wants us to glory in his resurrection. No more sadness. Jesus makes all things new. His resurrection brings new life in all of us. Let your old self die and put on your new self in

Christ. Please draw close to Christ now. You may be upset with yourself that you did not spend much time with Christ during lent. Just approach Christ where you are at now.

In the gospel, on Easter Sunday, we see Mary Magdala, Peter, and the other disciple approaching the tomb in which Jesus laid. Jesus is not in the tomb. He is risen. Jesus defies the human condition of death. Jesus comes back to life after dying on the cross. That my friends is a supernatural miracle. People who die do not come back to life. Especially if he has been lying dead in the tomb for three days. Jesus promises new life to all those who follow him and love him. If we die, we may not come back to life again like Lazarus and Jesus but we will experience new life in heaven. Jesus said that he is the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Christ.

What does all this mean? We must approach Jesus immediately and without hesitation. Go to him in prayer. Go to him in the sacrament of reconciliation, communion, and the anointing of the sick. Next Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. If you have not been to confession in a while please go this week. Set up an appointment with me or go to confession on Saturday morning at 8:30am or 3:50pm. 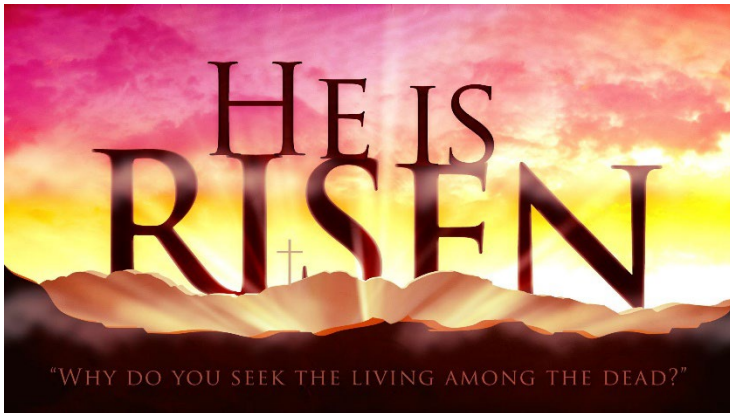

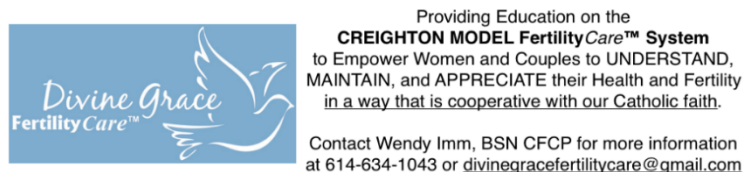
