**From the
Desk of
Fr. Matt**

A little over a year ago, on a Sunday I just got done celebrating and after Mass I was standing by the door of the church greeting the people as they were leaving. A mother and her teenage son came up to talk with the me, and the Mom was embarrassed/not happy about something that her son did/did not do. He did not receive communion. So, I asked the teen “Why didn’t you receive?” The teen responded by saying “I have sin on my conscience that prevents me from receiving communion.” Under normal circumstances I believe that kids should be obedient to what their parents are asking of them. I believe that kids should honor their parents. But this day was an exception to that, I believe that this teen was right not to receive communion and told him “if your conscience is telling you that you have a sin on soul that you need to go to confession before you receive communion, you made the right decision.” This teen’s mother was not happy with my answer, and think her

not being happy was more out of embarrassment. As embarrassed as she may have felt, I would venture to guess most people did not even notice what her son did. Her son did not do anything wrong; he actually did the right thing. I must admit that I admire this young man's faith.

It is easy to live our faith when it fits with the culture, when others are living the faith alongside of us, and when it draws little attention to ourselves. It is a challenge to live our faith with others alongside of us are doing something different, when we do what we do and draws attention to ourselves, or when it is challenging the culture. It is in these moments that we can stand out in the crowd and people may not like what we are doing so they might silence our voice or try to get us to change. In the scriptures Jeremiah is prophet and the message that he has is one that challenges the Israelite Culture, he wants them to live God's way. They do not like his message a matter of fact in our scriptures today we hear that "Jeremiah ought to be put to death" (Jeremiah 38:4). In this moment it would have been tempting for Jeremiah to back off his message, but he persists in preaching his message.

In our scriptures today Jesus tells his disciples that he has come "to set the world on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing" (Luke 12:49). Jesus goes onto say he has come to create division. For nearly twenty years, I have participated in many religious retreats, conferences, and seminars and almost every time these experiences set my heart on fire for the Lord. And this fire the Lord divides me apart from those who did not share in the experience. I often like to think this fire is one that I can only sense and feel, but I am know this is not the case. The fire of Christ ignited in my heart influences the way I live my life and those who know me well notice. Last summer, I helped to chaperon teens to a youth conference and when I got back a parishioner noticed a change in me. Christ sets a fire in our hearts, and it set us apart. The question is do you let that light shine through you?

REPORTING CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT

All suspected or actual acts of physical or sexual child abuse, or neglect, must be reported to the Putnam County Job and Family Services by calling 567-376-3777. Select "O" and ask to speak with someone from children's services and needing to make a referral. Hours are Monday- Thursday, 7AM to 4:30 PM, and Friday 7 AM to Noon. If incident is after hours, please call the Sheriff's Department at 419-523-3208. They will contact the caseworker on call and the caseworker will get back to the one reporting the incident--leave your contact number with the Sheriff Department person. The person who witnessed or was told is to be the person to make the call.

2. Report incident to the Diocese of Toledo after County Caseworker has been notified by calling the Diocesan Private Victim's Coordinator at 419-214-4880. 3. Notify Pastor, if not already notified.

4. With Pastor's discretion, next call parents and give basic information, while not disclosing any personal information.

As a worker with youth, you are a Mandated Reporter--You are required by law to report information to the State of Ohio through the above procedure.
