We hear from Isaiah today and he says, “Thus says the LORD: All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money, come, receive grain and eat; Come, without paying and without cost, drink wine and milk! God wants us to come to him and drink of his wisdom. Jesus tells us that he is the living water. Notice that God says

come to the water. He can not make us come to him. It has to be a free choice. We can choose to sit at the feet of the master or just listen to the world.

In today's gospel we see that Jesus' heart was moved with pity for the vast crowd that was in his midst. This crowd needed healing and needed that living water that Jesus gives. Then Jesus takes the five loaves and two fish and multiplies them so that the whole crowd ate and were satisfied. Christ knows our needs but he does not make people get cured. Jesus does not make us eat. God wants us to acknowledge the mighty works he performs in our presence. God takes care of us and our families. We may think that we do all the work but God is working behind the scenes to direct and lead us. Jesus is opening up doors so that we can enter. The blessings that we experience are not of our own doing. The seed grows in the field while the farmer is sleeping. The rain falls upon the field while the farmer is sleeping. God bless you all.

Please go on your Virtus account and make sure that your role is marked "CYO Coach" then Virtus will not take you through the online workshop. You need to attend an actual live class. Please do all of the other requirements that need to be updated before closing your account. **Go to this Diocesan CYO link <https://toledodiocese.org/cyo/page/coaches-certification> to take The Concussion Course and a Certificate of Completion must be submitted to rectory to be sent to the CYO Office good for 3 years. Sudden Cardiac Arrest courses must be taken each year on this link and will automatically be posted to your Virtus account. If a coach fails to maintain current certification, the coach loses his/her eligibility to coach.** Remember that your background check is good for 5 years. No need to do that every year. PARISH POLICY FOR CYO HIGH SCHOOL & PUTNAM COUNTY GRADE SCHOOL BOY'S & GIRL'S SPORTING TEAMS

ANNOUNCEMENT: Playing any sports this year? You are expected to attend both the Fall & Winter sessions of High School Religious Education Groups or Grade School CCD Classes---plus weekend Saturday or Sunday Mass. This includes all players, coaches and their families. Attendance at these groups/classes will be monitored and reviewed. For each class missed (which is not an excused absence) you will be sitting out one game.—**To play CYO sports, the following are the only excused absences from CCD: sickness, death in family, college visitation day, parish sponsored event, sport tournament games only with O-G athletes/fans involved, and work (up to 3 missed CCD classes due to work). After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class.** All other reasons are unexcused. Parents, if your child is sick, please call his/her teacher/leader before class. If necessary, the Parish Council will review attendance or unexcused absence issues on an individual basis.
