It has been great to meet, and it is privilege for me to serve you as pastor. Moving to Glandorf the pace of life has slowed down a little bit, but I know with school soon to start the pace of life is soon to pick up. But before that I thought I would take some time for vacation. In our scriptures today Jesus instructs us to enter through the narrow way, the narrow way living the way Christ points out to us. Some days it is easy to live that narrow way and other days in can be hardest thing. The consensus of the readings this weekend is a calling back to the Lord of His people and of all people. In the book of Isaiah, the theme is that Israel's God is the Lord of all nations and that He is calling the people that are scattered across Babylon, to come back to Jerusalem to worship the one true, God. We are all called to Jerusalem to worship the Lord and that Jerusalem is the heavenly Jerusalem that we long for at the end of our time here on earth. In the Gospel reading Jesus says, "that only a few will enter the narrow gate and that many will attempt but won't be strong enough. We as followers of Christ builds strength by our prayer life. We get stronger by allowing ourselves a discipline that involves putting God first when we wake up and that prayer time starting out the day, gets us on the right track to enter the narrow gate. Ending the day with prayer also keeps us on the right path. How strong is our prayer life? Do we spend time in prayer each day or is this only a weekend time with God? Allow God into your hearts so He can make a difference in your life. Eventually we can then enter that narrow gate and spend eternity in that heavenly Jerusalem. Peace and may God be with you.
