#### **Minutes for Parish Council Meeting - January 18, 2016**

**1.** Capital Campaign update: Pledged - \$683,965 and Paid - \$484,378. **2.** Conrad Schmitt is in the process of booking work for 2017 and wanted to know our position for scheduling purposes. In order to avoid missing another year, we decided to go through the original quote to see which church projects we could afford and which ones we could postpone. By reducing work on the North sacristy, on the choir loft and several other areas, we can move forward on the project using parish funds along with the funds currently pledged to the Capital Campaign. If more funds become available before the start of the project we may be able to add some of these items back in. A motion was made to go ahead with a revised lower quote and allow Conrad Schmitt to begin in January 2017 by Chris Hoehn and seconded by Jan Schroeder. The motion was approved. **3.** We reviewed adjustments made to the cemetery rules to coincide with diocesan regulations. A motion to approve the rules was made by Dale Warnecke and seconded by Brian Schroeder. The motion was approved. **4.** We looked over and supported the parish policy on texting, pictures, and use of social media, in regards to protecting the youth and those who serve them. **5.** Three resumes have been received for the position of business manager. Interviews will begin in February, and we hope to have the position filled by 3-1-16. **6.** The Eucharistic Day went well. The Parish Center Museum continues to get good comments, and more items are still coming in. **7.** The church was dusted and parts of the parish center cleaned by 53 students as a service project, courtesy of Scott Ketner. **PARISH POLICY FOR CYO HIGH SCHOOL & PUTNAM COUNTY GRADE SCHOOL BOY'S & GIRL'S SPORTING TEAMS ANNOUNCEMENT:** Playing any sports this year? You are expected to attend both the Fall & Winter sessions of High School Religious Education Groups or Grade School CCD Classes---plus weekend Saturday or Sunday Mass. This includes all players, coaches and their families. Attendance at these groups/classes will be monitored and reviewed. For each class missed (which is not an excused absence) you will be sitting out one game.—**To play CYO sports, the following are the only excused absences from CCD: sickness, death in family, college visitation day, parish sponsored event, sport tournament games only with O-G athletes/fans involved, and work (up to 3 missed CCD classes due to work). After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class.** All other reasons are unexcused. Parents, if your child is sick, please call his/her teacher/leader before class. If necessary, the Parish Council will review attendance or unexcused absence issues on an individual basis. We kindly ask the cooperation of all concerned as we implement this church policy for the good of our parish. **Any non-Catholic youth** living in our parish is eligible to play CYO sports, if they regularly attend our parish High School Religious Education Groups or Grade School CCD Classes & plus regularly attend their Sunday service. This must be documented with their pastor's signature that they attended services each week during pre-season practices and regular season games.
