SNOW EMERGENCY LEVELS

Diocese of Toledo Snow Emergency Policy: "Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency, during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. If Putnam County is ever under a Level 3 Snow Emergency the regular Mass times will be canceled here at St. John's. There will be a Mass at Noon, if you can get here safely you are welcome. If not, we encourage you to watch it on cable channel 3 or on our Youtube page. Level 1 and Level 2 if you can get here safely you are welcome.

From the Desk of Fr. Matt

“Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29). Are the words that we hear John echo in our scriptures today. John uses these words to point Jesus out and to say that Jesus is the son of God. Our scriptures stop short today because what follows John pointing out Jesus, is the next day John’s disciples follow Jesus and have an encounter with Jesus.

Each time I celebrate Mass the moment just before receiving communion I echo these same words “Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world”. And what follows this we receive the Eucharist, and we have an encounter with Christ. And it is from our encounter with Christ we are called to draw other to encounter Christ. Through my ministry as a priest and through the Sacrament of Holy Orders, I show Christ to the world so that others can have encounter with Christ.

But this pointing out of Christ so that others can have an encounter with Christ is not limited to those who are ordained or those who live a consecrated life as religious brothers and sisters. Through the Sacrament of Matrimony, a couple is meant to be a sign of the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world, the love a husband-and-wife share is meant to be sign of Christ’s love that is called to draw others to encounter Jesus. Our natural inclination is thinking of this happening through the raising of children in faith or the generosity a couple might share with their time or treasure that help to bring others to encounter Jesus. The love that they share among themselves that is sign of Christ’s love that draws to encounter Christ.

It is not just through our vocation call that we are called to show Christ to the world so that others can have an encounter with Christ. It is by the grace of all the sacraments that we show Christ to the world so that others can have encounter with Christ. This begins with our baptism; at our baptism we received a mark to be that sign of Christ on our lives to draw others to Christ. The other sacraments give us that grace so that we radiate Christ to the world to draw others to Christ. Our confirmation students today will be participating in the Rite of Enrollment for Confirmation and as they prepare for confirmation, they are not only preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation, but they are preparing to be sign that will draw others to Christ. Through the grace of the sacrament, they are going to be strengthened so that they can draw others to Christ. We pray for our confirmation students during this time of preparation.

The sacraments draw us to have an encounter with Christ and it is from our encounter with Christ we called to draw others to have an encounter with Christ. The question I think then becomes how are we through the example of our lives drawing others to encounter Christ?

If we examine our lives, I venture to guess we can all point examples of how in our lives we draw others to encounter, we might even celebrate these examples.

But I would venture to guess that we all have plenty of examples in our lives were we are not drawing others to encounter Christ and there even might be examples where we might be even drawing people away from Christ. We might be ashamed or embarrassed by these examples and for these examples we might need the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As we journey this day may the Lord strengthen us to give better witness to him.
