**2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**

Paul tells the Corinthians today in the second reading, "Brothers and sisters: There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit

is given for some benefit. To one is given through the Spirit the expression of wisdom; to another, the expression of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another, faith by the same Spirit; to another, gifts of healing by the one Spirit; to another, mighty deeds; to another, prophecy."

God did not make us all the same. We are not clones and we are not meant to be spiritual clones. There are different gifts but the same spirit. If someone is not like me, it is not my mission to make them like me. When people tell you that in order to be a good Christian you have to pray like me and serve other people like me, that is your cue to be cautious around that person.

We cannot be an expert in everything. We are meant to depend on each other. We are not meant to be lone rangers also. Humans are meant to be together and support one another. We are meant to bring our gifts to those around us without any strings attached. I use my gifts not to advance in the sight of others but to fulfill a need of another. Let us reexamine our motives in service. God has given me my strengths and gifts and it is my duty to exercise those gifts in my parish community. God bless you all. Fr. Tony
