**JANUARY 2  
Epiphany of the Lord**

Today we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. The three wise men follow the star and found the Christ child and his family, Mary and Joseph. “They were overjoyed at seeing the star,

and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and

myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.”

Time and again we see that discipleship demands obedience to God. Joseph is told by God to take Mary as his wife and then Joseph is warned in a dream to take the baby Jesus and Mary to Egypt to flee from King Herod, who killed all the babies in Bethlehem. Herod wanted to get rid of the Christ child. The three wise men have been warned in a dream not to return to Herod. Herod wanted to know from the wise men what they saw in Bethlehem. The first pastor I served under, told me the first day at the parish to be obedient. Obedience allows for God’s will and not always our will. Obedience is a sign of wisdom. Let us obediently follow the Lord each day and allow him to instruct us by his word.

This week we also celebrated Mary, Mother of God. Let Mary be your mother also. Pray the rosary every day. God will reward you for that.

When Jesus sees you respecting and talking to his mother, he will bless you. Every son wants others to respect their mother.
