**5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent**

**MARCH 18, 2018**

Today Jesus tells us that we must be like that grain of wheat that dies in order to bear fruit. He goes on to tell us that we must not love our lives but lose them for the sake of Christ and his gospel. Those who love their lives will lose them. Jesus is teaching us to give our lives away completely. This is a very difficult task for you and me because we like to hold on to things.
