Fr. Tony**

A priest told me one time that "You don't want to perish in the parish." That is a play on words but that priest was telling me to stay holy and repent. Jesus tells us twice today, "If you do not repent, you will perish." We must tell the Lord we are sorry for our offenses. We all need to repent from something. None of us are squeaky clean. Repentance brings forth a change of heart. When we repent we have to repent to someone. Repentance allows us to say sorry to God and others. When you repent you are putting yourself in a vulnerable position. People may not forgive you but God will.

The only way one can save them self is through telling God they are sorry. It is hard to believe that the simple act of repentance can save one from eternal damnation. But it can. If you don't repent then God cannot get you where you need to be. Not repenting is like a stumbling block on your path. Many times people don't repent because of pride. 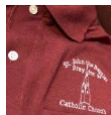
