Many would say that the father should disown him for being so irresponsible. But the father welcomes back his son even though he wasted his money. In fact, when the son returns back to the father, the father kills the fatted calf and puts a ring on the sons finger. The father says, "Then let us celebrate with a feast, because this son of mine was dead, and has come to life again; he was lost, and has been found."

The father is happy that the son found his way back home again. The father is happy that his son was not so prideful that he could not return home. The father is happy that his son came to his senses and realized that he

would be taken care of by his father. Brothers and sisters God is like this father in Jesus' parable today. We are like that younger son. We sin and wonder away from God. We to live a life of dissipation, of sin, and hopefully our pride does not keep us away from God and his mercy. God is full of love and mercy. He is waiting for us to return to him.

There are times when we think that we do not need God. That we don't need to pray and spend time with God. So we go off on our own and watch our life slowly crumble. God is patiently watching for us to return to him. If some of us have not been to confession in a long time, now is the time to go. Don't put it off. Our lives will not turn around and get better unless we participate in the sacrament of reconciliation. We have to admit our faults to God and then allow his graces and blessings to transform us.
