In today's gospel Jesus becomes very upset with the money changers. The people needed to exchange their roman coins for temple coins. The money changers made that conversion of coin. Why was this needed? Because the roman coins were considered unclean money and if the Jewish people were buying holy objects or lambs for sacrifice, they had to use the temple money and not the pagan roman coins. The money changers would often gouge the Jewish

people in the exchange rate. This made Jesus very upset.

Jesus respected the temple because he saw the temple as his Father's house. That house was to be a house of prayer and not a marketplace.

Every home is holy but some places like our church are meant for prayer and celebrating the sacraments.

Today we also see Jesus speaking about the destruction of the temple and how he will reconstruct it in three days. Jesus was talking about the temple of his body. How Jesus would be killed on the cross and in three days the temple of his body will rise. Jesus can do all things. When things go bad, let us trust that Jesus can make all things new. missed CCD classes due to work). After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class. All other reasons are unexcused.
