**29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

October 21<sup>st</sup> is the feast day of St. Gaspar del Bufalo. St. Gaspar founded the Precious Blood of Jesus apostolic community on 1815. Br. Jerry, Fr. Rick, Fr. Matt, in Ottawa, Fr. Mark, in Kalida, and I belong to the Missionaries of the Precious Blood Community. The Precious Blood community has been in Putnam County, Mercer County, and the Sorrowful Mother Shrine in Bellevue, Ohio since the 1840's. St. Gaspar preached missions and retreats in Rome, Italy and areas around Rome. He wanted people to know the healing power of the Precious Blood of Jesus. You and I are so blest to be able to receive Jesus' body and blood each day. We can sometimes take that for granted. St. Gaspar endured much suffering during his life. He was a sickly man but would not let his infirmities slow him down. He could not see when he was young but later regained his sight. St. Gaspar endured the Napoleonic era and St. Gaspar was put into prison for three years because he would not pledge allegiance to Napoleon. At that time in Europe, Napoleon wanted all religious to pledge allegiance to him instead of the pope.

St. Gaspar performed many miracles. He could bilocate, which means he could be in two places at once. One day he was preaching in the street and hearing confessions in a church at the same time. His prayers healed many people who were sick. Make sure you ask St. Gaspar to pray for you each day. Our Lady of the Precious Blood and St. Gaspar pray for us. God bless you all. Fr. Tony
