Today is the feast day of St. Gaspar del Buffalo, the founder of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood Community. This is the community that Br. Jerry, Fr. Rick, Fr. Matt, Fr. Mark, and I belong to. St. Gaspar followed the Lord's promptings by starting a community of brothers and priests who have a devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ. St. Gaspar wanted all people to know the power in blood of Christ. We drink the Precious Blood of Jesus each time we go to mass. This blood is what gains us access to heaven. There are times that I repeat throughout the day, "Precious Blood of Jesus heal me." The Precious Blood of Jesus can heal our mind, body, and soul.

When the children are walking to and from religious education in the morning, I often speak out loud, "Precious Blood of Jesus heal these children and their teachers." Parents you might want to do that before your children go to bed. You might want to ask the Precious Blood of Jesus to cover your children throughout the day so that God protects them from evil. It is an evil world and we all need that divine intervention at times. St. Gaspar worked many miracles. He could bi-locate, which means he could be in two places at once. There was one time when he was hearing confessions in the church and at the same time preaching outside of that same church. He would often levitate, which means he was lifted off of the ground. This happened when he was meditating on the crucifix. Ask St. Gaspar to pray for you and your family. St. Gaspar pray that this parish is filled with God's love, peace, and joy.
