SEPTEMBER 3, 2017**

Today Jesus tells the apostles that he must go to Jerusalem and be crucified and killed. Peter does not like to hear this and he tells Jesus that no such thing should ever happen to Jesus. Jesus then tells Peter, "Get behind me Satan, you are thinking as men do and not as God thinks." Jesus then tells his apostles that they must take up their cross daily and follow Christ's teachings. Jesus says that those who save their lives will lose them and those who lose their life for my sake will find their life.

Jesus is always encouraging us to let go of our lives in order to find meaning in our lives. Jesus wants to be in total control of our life. We have to give up some of those things we like in order to spend more time being with and serving others. We can do some things we like. Like going on vacation or going out to eat every once in a while. Each one of us has to take care of ourselves. But we have to give more than we get.

Sometimes we cannot take other people's pain and crosses away from them. Peter wanted to take the cross away from Jesus also. Sometimes the best thing for a person is to endure their cross. You and I can accompany those who are enduring their crosses. That is a way we can show love. We can be another Simon of Cyrene. We cannot always take cancer away from our loved ones. Sometimes a relative or friend may have to go to jail for a crime. We cannot take that away also. Just sitting with people in their pain can be a help. God bless you all. Fr. Tony

After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class.** All other reasons are unexcused. Parents, if your child is sick, please call his/her teacher/leader before class. If necessary, the Parish Council will review attendance or unexcused absence issues on an individual basis. We kindly ask the cooperation of all concerned as we implement this church policy for the good of our parish.
